If the Final Fixing Value is below the Cap Level, the performance is equal to the Maximum Yield (0.620830%). If, on the other hand, the Final Fixing Value is at the same level or above the Cap Level, the performance of the product is inverse to that of the Underlying. The discount reduces the negative performance of the product accordingly.

3. Material Risks for Investors

Issuer Risk

Obligations under these products constitute direct, unconditional and unsecured obligations of the Issuer and rank pari passu with other direct, unconditional and unsecured obligations of the Issuer. The value of the product not only depends on the performance of the Underlying and other developments in the financial markets, but also on the solvency of the Issuer, which may change during the term of this product.

Specific product risks

Structured products are complex financial instruments, which entail considerable risks and, accordingly, are only suitable for investors who have the requisite knowledge and experience and understand thoroughly the risks connected with an investment in these structured products and are capable of bearing the economic risks. The loss potential of an investment in a ZKB Discount Certificate is limited to the difference between the purchase price and the redemption amount according to „Redemption Method“ if the Final Fixing Value is at or above the Cap Level. The redemption amount can be significantly lower than the purchase price.

The investor bears a possible liquidity risk, as no selling price is provided and only Zürcher Kantonalbank provides a buying price. Therefore, investors may only be able to sell their structured products at a price that is lower than the actual value of the structured products at the time of their sale. The product is denominated in AUD. If the investor's reference currency differs from the AUD, the investor bears the risk between the AUD and his reference currency.

4. Additional Terms

Modifications

If an extraordinary event as described in the Base Prospectus occurs in relation to an Underlying/Component of the Underlying or if any other extraordinary event occurs, which makes it impossible or particularly cumbersome for the Issuer, to fulfill its obligations under the products or to calculate the value of the products, the Issuer shall at its own discretion take all the necessary actions and, if necessary may modify the terms and conditions of these products at its own discretion in such way, that the economic value of the products after occurrence of the extraordinary event corresponds, to the extent possible, to the economic value of the products prior to the occurrence of the extraordinary event.

Change of Obligor
