If a Knock-in Event occurs, the performance of the product is always given by the Coupons paid out during the term. If a Knock-in Event occurs and if the Final Fixing Value of the Underlying is below the Cap Level, the investor receives a cash repayment corresponding to the Denomination divided by the Cap Level and multiplied by the Final Fixing Value of the worst performing Underlying.
