The Coupon of 7.9948% p.a. is divided into a premium payment of 6.0987% p.a. and an interest payment of 1.896% p.a The option premium part qualifies as capital gain and is not subject to Swiss income tax for private investors with Swiss tax domicile. The interest payment is subject to income tax and is determined in compliance with the 'modifizierte Differenzbesteuerung' tax rule based on the ESTV Bondfloor Pricing method. The Swiss withholding tax is not levied. In the case of physical delivery of the Underlying at maturity, the federal securities transfer stamp is levied on the basis of the Cap Level. The Federal securities transfer stamp tax is levied on secondary market transactions. If a Knock-in Event occurs, the performance of the product is always given by the Coupons paid out during the term. If a Knock-in Event occurs and if the Final Fixing Value of the Underlying is below the Cap Level , the investor will receive a physical delivery of a number of Underlyings as defined in Ratio. Therefore, the investor may suffer a partial or total loss. The acquisition price of the delivered Underlyings is 100.00% of the Initial Fixing Value. This negative performance is reduced by the guaranteed Coupons paid out during the term. The table above is valid at maturity only and is by no means meant as a price indication for the present product throughout its lifetime. 3. Material Risks for Investors

Obligations under these products constitute direct, unconditional and unsecured obligations of the Issuer and rank pari passu with other direct, unconditional and unsecured obligations of the Issuer. The value of the product not only depends on the performance of the Underlying and other developments in the financial markets, but also on the solvency of the Issuer, which may change during the term of this product.

If an extraordinary event as described in the Base Prospectus occurs in relation to an Underlying/Component of the Underlying or if any other extraordinary event occurs, which makes it impossible or particularly cumbersome for the Issuer, to fulfill its obligations under the products or to calculate the value of the products, the Issuer shall at its own discretion take all the necessary actions and, if necessary may modify the terms and conditions of these products at its own discretion in such way, that the economic value of the products after occurrence of the extraordinary event corresponds, to the extent possible, to the economic value of the products prior to the occurrence of the extraordinary event.
