	2. Profit and Loss Expectations at Maturity
Profit and Loss Expectations at Maturity	ZKB Mini-Futures Long offer the opportunity to benefit overproportionately from a positive performance of the Underlying. The profit outlook is basically unlimited for ZKB Mini-Futures Long. The potential loss of ZKB Mini-Futures Long is limited to the invested capital. ZKB Mini-Futures Long are derivatives whose risk is correspondingly greater than the risk of the Underlying due to the leverage effect.
	In the event of a Stop-Loss Event, the actual execution price of the closing out of the ZKB Mini-Future Long may diverge sharply from the Current Stop-Loss Level, which is only to be seen as the trigger of a Stop-Loss Event, not as an actual indication of the Redemption Amount of the Product that can be effectively reached.
	3. Material Risks for Investors
