If the Final Fixing Value of all Underlyings is at or above the Cap Level, the performance of the product is always given by the Coupons paid out during the term. However, if the Final Fixing Value of at least one Underlying is below the Cap Level, the investor receives a cash repayment corresponding to the Denomination divided by the Cap Level and multiplied by the Final Fixing Value of the worst performing Underlying. Therefore, the investor may suffer a partial or total loss. The acquisition price is 90.00% of the Initial Fixing Value, which means that the performance of the product is less negative than the performance of the Underlying. This negative performance is reduced by the guaranteed Coupons paid out during the term. The table above is valid at maturity only and is by no means meant as a price indication for the present product throughout its lifetime. Additional risk factors may have a significant impact on the value of the product during the term. The price quoted on the secondary market can therefore deviate substantially from the above table. For this table it was assumed, that Puma SE was the worst performing Underlying. This selection is just a representative example of the possible alternatives. 3. Material Risks for Investors

The value of the product not only depends on the performance of the Underlying and other developments in the financial markets, but also on the solvency of the Issuer, which may change during the term of this product.

4. Additional Terms
