Depending on the Underlyings' performance, the product pays out coupons on defined dates during the term. Unpaid coupons can be obtained at later coupon dates thanks to the memory effect. This product is a combined investment instrument that essentially consists of a fixed income security and the sale of a down-and-in put option. This allows the investor to benefit from the current volatility of the Underlyings. An above-average return is achieved when prices fall slightly, stagnate or rise slightly. If no Knock-in Event occurs, the investor will receive a physical delivery of a number of Underlyings of the Underlying with the worst performance between Initial Fixing Date and Final Fixing Date.
