If the Final Fixing Value is below the Cap Level, the performance is equal to the Maximum Yield (0.809444%). If, on the other hand, the Final Fixing Value is at the same level or above the Cap Level, the performance of the product is inverse to that of the Underlying. The discount reduces the negative performance of the product accordingly.

4. Additional Terms

Modifications

If an extraordinary event as described in the Base Prospectus occurs in relation to an Underlying/Component of the Underlying or if any other extraordinary event occurs, which makes it impossible or particularly cumbersome for the Issuer, to fulfill its obligations under the products or to calculate the value of the products, the Issuer shall at its own discretion take all the necessary actions and, if necessary may modify the terms and conditions of these products at its own discretion in such way, that the economic value of the products after occurrence of the extraordinary event corresponds, to the extent possible, to the economic value of the products prior to the occurrence of the extraordinary event.
