Key elements of the product	A ZKB Autocallable Reverse Convertible Defensive is an investment instrument that can be redeemed early on defined dates depending on the performance of the Underlying. The product pays out coupons on defined dates during the term. This product is a combined investment instrument that essentially consists of a fixed income security and the sale of a put option. This allows the investor to benefit from the current volatility of the Underlying. An above-average return is achieved when prices fall slightly, stagnate or rise slightly. If the Final Fixing Value of the Underlying is at or above the Cap Level, the investor receives a cash redemption in the amount of the Denomination. If the Final Fixing Value of the Underlying is below the Cap Level, the investor will receive a physical delivery of a number of Underlyings.
